We have been really busy learning about the Great Fire of London and writing explanation texts about how the fire started.

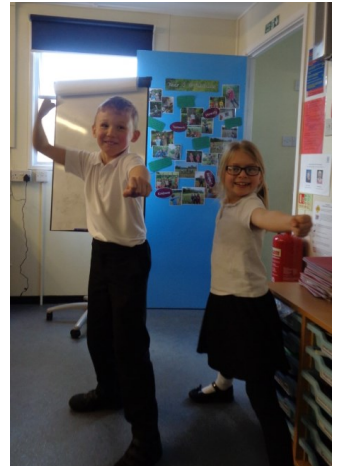
