We look forward to seeing the children in their World Book Day costumes next Friday.


Seacole







Lewis

Cleaner & Key Holder - Grade A

We are looking for a motivated and experienced individual to join our friendly and hardworking Ventrus Team to assist with cleaning duties at Sampford Peverell C of E School.

Using your previous skills in the cleaning of buildings or facilities, you will provide the cleaning of designated classrooms, shared spaces and other non-teaching working spaces. Working outside of school hours, you will need to be committed to working two hours per day on cleaning duties. During the School holidays, you will need to cover a rota of work to be completed during this period. You will need to be flexible due to some changes in the school timetable for events throughout the year.

You must be able to manually move tables, chairs and other classroom furniture safely in order to clean the rooms. You will also be the designated 'key holder', responsible for locking and unlocking of the school.
