This week in Lewis Class, the children have been working hard practising their times tables particularly. Also, they have been getting ready for our puppet workshop and performance next week, learning the story and starting to think about their design for their own puppet.

In class this week we have been investigating how to create a circuit and then what happens when we add more components to it. We have then drawn a scientific circuit diagram to illustrate our work.

In English we have been looking to add descriptive writing to the amazing story of 'The Snowman' by Raymond Briggs. The children have thought of some excellent ideas linked to adding adverbials and conjunctions.

In Maths we have just begun looking at fractions – focussing at the moment on finding equivalents and then ordering them.

On top of this we have also looked at the route Sir Francis Drake took when circumnavigating the globe and creating our lantern ready for the parade
