- ✓ care for your child's safety and well-being
- ✓ provide a broad and balanced curriculum which is mindful of the needs of all children within a Christian environment
- ✓ recognise your child as an individual and encourage all children to reach their full potential as valued members of the school community

- develop your child's independence and responsibility so they can progress confidently through the school and continue to do so after they leave

- Provide information and helpful training sessions for you that will give you confidence to support your child.

- ✓ attend meetings with my child's teacher aiming to be positive and work together with the school to support my child
- ✓ send my child to school with appropriate named uniform, PE kit and anything else required such as a water bottle or clothing for trips
- ✓ find out about my child's school life and the values of the school
