EXMOOR CHALLENGE

On the 29th of April, ten children from Year 6 participated in the Exmoor Challenge. They gathered excitedly (but nervously) in Dulverton School's playground preparing to go—equipment checked; boots done up; and maps at the ready.

Team-by-team they were called forward for the last check and then they were off! With parents and other supporters cheering them on, they marched confidently to checkpoint 1 at Marsh Bridge. Whilst taking full advantage of the delightful café at checkpoint 1, Mr Snow and accompanying adults clapped them through - there were no such luxuries for the children - as each of the three teams made good time and checked in without any issues.

Roughly halfway through the 16 miles, at Anstey Gate, the first group were making almost perfect time with very few time penalties. The second were also making very good time as was the final pair who were walking with two children from Halberton.

Between Anstey Gate and the next recommended view point at Mounsey Hill Gate, the route began to take its toll on the groups with all three showing real grit and determination to push on up the tough climb after Tarr Steps. However, each group remained positive and continued towards their goal of finishing.

Finally, after over 6 hours of constant walking, every member of every team made it in sight of the finish line; it was such a moment of joy that many of the children began running towards the finish once it came into view (not something you would have found me doing after 16 miles!)

It was an absolutely amazing day for both children and accompanying adults as all the children finished. I would like to thank David Curnow for leading the practice walks and for offering advice to the children on how to read maps and take compass bearings. Lorna Davey also came back to Sampford to help supervise the walks and even showed up on the day to cheer the children on. I would also like to thank all of the parents who have offered support on the practice walks and also on the day itself (with Des Keenoy getting an extra special thanks for chauffeuring me around and for Julian Ewings and Rose Partridge for battling through personal injuries on the walks—I couldn't have done it without all of this help).
