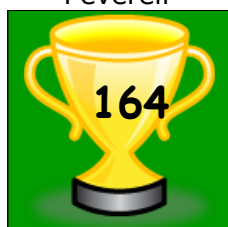

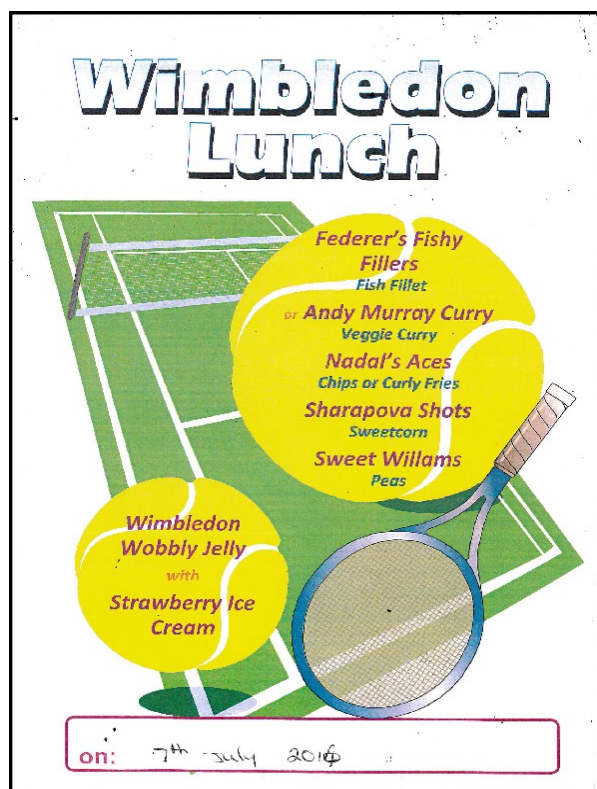
PTFA News
