
## **Darwin Class (Reception)**

Another busy fortnight has flown by and Darwin Class have started learning all about 'Autumn' and the change of the seasons. We have enjoyed reading our class text of 'After the Storm', which has been handy to coincide with this wet and windy weather! We are all looking forward to getting out into the school grounds to look for evidence of autumn materials. If you find any beautiful orange, yellow or red leaves, conkers or pine cones, please do bring them in.



### Seacole (Years 1 and 2)

This week we have started to design and plan our own stories based on the structure of our current English text, Augustus and his smile. We have decided on our main characters and had to draw and describe them. This is Lev's main character!



#### Lewis Class (Years 3 and 4)

Lewis class have begun looking at sound in science over the past 2 weeks. We've carried out lots of hands on investigations into how sounds are made, as well as how the volume and pitch can be change. Please encourage your child to think about the different sounds they hear and encourage them to try and explain how they think those sounds are made.



#### Drake (Years 5 and 6)

Over the last two weeks Drake class have switched their attentions to science and in particular the human body. We have investigated and simulated how blood moves around our bodies (circulatory system) and how water and nutrients are removed are absorbed by the body (digestive system). In English, we are looking at an amazing book called 'Anatomy' to help us write some explanations about the digestive system (which we will be completing next week). In maths, we have moved onto addition, subtraction and multiplication - looking at using the formal methods (columns) and solving multi-step problems linked to them. Last week, the Y5 members of the class completed their Bikeability qualifications in varying weathers so the children showed some really great perseverance - many thanks to Carol Booth for leading and arranging the sessions.
