Lewis Class (Years 3 and 4)

Lewis class have begun their new science unit on plants

this week. Miss Holland took us out searching for different plants in the school grounds and we looked closely at what we could see on them. Lots of them had buds and we even found a few flowers! Afterwards, we looked at the different parts of a flowering plant and the function of each part. Did you know that the leaves help plants produce their own food?



Drake Class (Years 5 and 6)

In Drake Class this week we have started our new topic on The Ancient Egyptians. During the next few weeks,

will be focussing our writing on this topic as well as using historical investigation techniques to try to uncover information of this fascinating time period. In art we are linking our sculpture and clay unit to the Egyptians too by creating some pottery in the Egyptian style – this week we practised using



plasticine to create coil pots with fantastic results (see picture). In maths, we are continuing to build knowledge of the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages. In PE, we have been completing daily yoga sessions to help focus our minds and in RE we are studying Judaism – where the children have been coming up with some fantastic questions about the Jewish faith.
