
UPCOMING EVENTS

Watermouth Castle offers a fantastic family day out with thrilling rides like the Toboggan Run, adventure play areas, a mini-golf course, hedge maze, and castlethemed attractions. Set in beautiful gardens overlooking Watermouth Cove, it features quirky Victorian exhibits, arcades, and special shows vintage making it perfect for fun and adventure for all ages.

Fancy a swim? **Active Mid Devon** is the place to go!They also offer over 100 fitness classes each week, fully equipped gyms, swimming pools with lessons, along with racquet sports, birthday parties, and teen fitness programs.



Happy Glaze Pottery is a friendly paint-your-own pottery studio in Tiverton, Devon, welcoming all ages and abilities. Visitors can choose from a wide range of bisque items like mugs, plates, money banks, and figurines to paint and personalize. The studio provides all the tools, tips, and support needed to bring your creative ideas to life. Whether you're a beginner or experienced, it's a fun and relaxing place to express your creativity.





Tiverton Castle is a great place to visit. Visitors can explore the castle's medieval garderobes (loos), which were originally cleaned out by children, and learn about various ghost stories and secret passages. The castle also houses a fine collection of Civil War arms and armor, some of which can even be tried on.

Wildwood Devon, set in Escot Park near Ottery St Mary, is a family-friendly wildlife park with native animals like wolves, lynx, otters, and wild boar. Visitors can explore ancient woodlands, get lost in a huge beech hedge maze, enjoy outdoor play areas, and visit a reconstructed Saxon Village. With daily animal talks, nature trails, and a cosy café, it's a fun and educational day out for all ages.





Kents Cavern, in Torquay, Devon, takes you on a guided journey through one of Britain's most important Stone Age cave systems. Walk beneath 400-million-year-old rock formations, learn about Ice Age humans and extinct animals, and experience periods of total darkness.

Canonteign Falls, near Christow in Devon, is home to England's highest man-made waterfall, set within 90 acres of stunning woodland, lakes, and gardens. Visitors can climb through the historic Fern Garden for panoramic views, explore nature trails, fairy doors, and sculptures, or enjoy adventure playgrounds. With a lakeside café, gift shop, and dog-friendly grounds, it's a perfect family day out in nature.





The Milky Way Adventure Park, near Clovelly, offers all-weather family fun with rides, soft play, live shows, a sci-fi exhibit, and bird-of-prey displays. Kids love the indoor Time Warp, rollercoasters, bouncing pillows, and Little Stars play zone—most activities are included in the entry price for a great-value day out.

Seaton Tramway offers a scenic electric tram ride through East Devon's Axe Valley, running between Seaton, Colyford, and Colyton. Enjoy stunning views of wetlands and wildlife, with opportunities to hop off, explore nature trails, visit cafés, and take part in themed events—perfect for a relaxed family day out.





Devon Railway Centre, near Bickleigh, is a family-friendly attraction with unlimited train rides, model railways, a miniature railway through Magic Wood, indoor soft play, crazy golf, and interactive exhibits. With picnic spots and a café, it's a great all-weather day out for young children and train enthusiasts alike.

Park in North Devon offers close-up encounters with exotic animals like wolves, penguins, and sea lions alongside life-sized animatronic dinosaurs. Families can enjoy indoor soft play, a dinosaur-themed train ride, daily animal shows, and interactive experiences, all set in a beautiful 28-acre valley.





The Grand Pier, Weston-super-Mare offers year-round fun with over 500 arcade games, indoor rides like go-karts and ghost trains, soft play areas, mini golf, and family-friendly attractions. With restaurants and cafés on-site, it's a perfect spot for a lively day out by the sea.

Diggerland Devon in Cullompton is a unique construction-themed adventure park where families can drive and operate real diggers and machinery. With over 20 rides and attractions—including mini diggers, go-karts, and spinning rides—it offers hands-on fun for all ages, plus indoor play for all-weather visits.





Jurassic Discovery in Seaton features lifelike animatronic dinosaurs and interactive exhibits, plus a dinosaur-themed soft play area for kids. With an on-site café, it's a fun, educational day out for families.

Stuart Line Cruises from Exmouth offers scenic boat trips along the River Exe and Jurassic Coast, including wildlife tours, themed evening cruises, and coastal adventures.
